1. Every person signing the pledge & after a months consistent conduct having his name registered & card filled up by the Registrar to become a pledged member of the Society.
  2. Every pledged member who shall contribute not less than 1<sup>st</sup> per week to the funds of the Soc<sup>y</sup> to be <sup>constituted</sup> ~~constituted~~ a voting member.
  3. The Committee to be reorganized - & to consist of nine of the members now in office, <sup>and</sup> six others to be chosen by the <sup>voting</sup> members at large from a list carefully prepared by the present Committee; & in future at each annual <sup>meeting</sup> the six members at the head of the list according to alphabetical arrangement to retire from office, & be replaced by six chosen in the way above mentioned by the members at large. Members retiring from office to be capable of re-appoint<sup>ment</sup> by the members.
  4. To promote the better attendance of <sup>other important objects</sup> public Meetings for advocacy, another place of meeting to be engaged or erected which shall combine 1. a capacious room wherein public Meetings might be held; second a reading room & Library;

3. a coffee-room; with accommoda-  
tion for <sup>the residence of</sup> at least of  
a respectable couple who ~~have~~
