E. & I milked the cow before breakfast & bathed.

Been fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield. Mark returned from Woodedon. Kate, George, & I, picked some red currants. Kate shut up some windows at Pine View. Played croquet. Doctor Stacy dined here, came to see Grey who has been ill.

29 FRIDAY [29-336]

Fine - cloudy S. Wind. Papa rode twice to Mayfield. Mark rode to the Saltwicks - to the scrub with George in the afternoon. Kate, & I, went to Longquite, to see Mr. Pool. I went to Fowler, while H. went into my garden to see Mr. Grey. Scotty dug out some of my pond. (Papa, Mark were.)

Morning. Kate, Bird & I got fruit & walked on the beach. Saw at Church & Sunday school.
