FISHES OF TASMANIA

1890 - 1930, possibly c.1920 - 1930

An incomplete descriptive list by an unidentified author. It is undated but was compiled later than R.M. Johnston's Fishes of Tasmania, published in Papers and Proceedings of the Royal Society of Tasmania in 1882 as Johnston's List is cited in this List. Johnston's List acknowledges help from M. Allport's ms. List of Fishes which has no description and which is also in the Royal Society's collection. (See RS. 128)

Drawings of Tasmanian fish

42 ink drawings or diagrams of fish, on papers 170 mm x 205 mm. Some have scientific names typed (small neat type, similar to the typed pages of the list above), some common names or corrected names in pencil. The drawings were stored between pieces of strawboard, marked ms "diagrams of Tas. fishes". The Roy. Soc. Library card stuck on, however, states: "Australian fishes, 40 hand drawn diagrams, Anonymous" The papers have a brownish colour, passibly due to acidity.
