- Mounted print (146 x 90mm) sepia enlargement of "The High School of Hobart Town designed by Alexander Dawson, 1848, Lithograph by Thomas Browne (held RS146/2)
- 3 Black and white framed (66 x 57mm) photographs of people at the Teachers College undated
- Metal plaque donated by the AFUW Tas in 1988 commemorating the Philip Smith Training College 1911, the Philip Smith Teachers College 1923, Hobart Teachers College 1963-1971 and the Southern Teachers Centre (no date)
